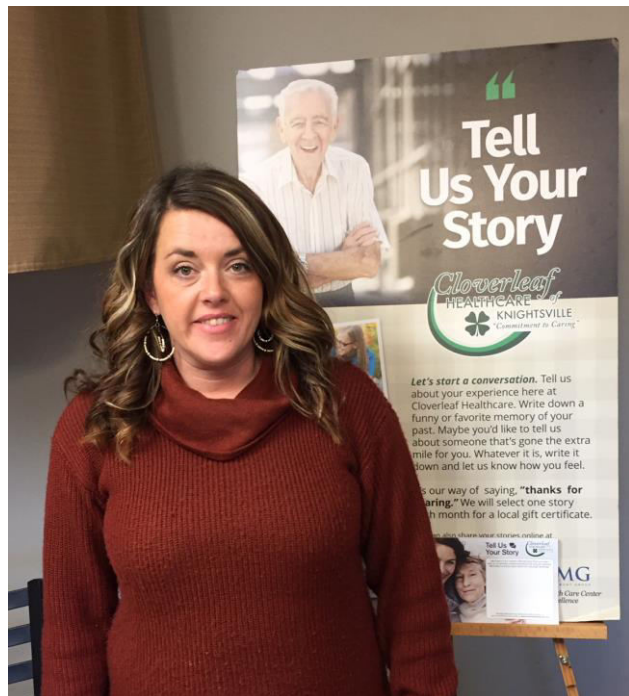

December Recipe of the Month

Red Velvet Poke Cake

Ingredients

1. 1 box of red velvet cake mix, with all ingredients already in box to make.
2. (3.4 oz) box of instant cheesecake-flavored pudding
3. 4 cups of milk
4. 8 ounce of frozen whipped cream
5. 10 oreo cookies

Directions

*prepare cake mix according to package directions

*9 x 13 cake pan.

*bake cake and allow to cool for a few minutes.

*poke holes in cake using wooden spoon handle.

*mix together the dry pudding mix with 4 cups of milk.

*pour pudding over cake allowing it to settle into the holes. Put cake in fridge to cool for 2 hours.

*once cake is cooled spread on whipped topping.

*crush oreo cookies in a bowl.

*spread oreo cookies on top of cake (do this immediately prior to serving cookies to make sure they are crunchy.
